Fiscal Year 2025 USDA Patrick Leahy Farm to School Grant

The Fiscal Year 2025 USDA Patrick Leahy Farm to School Grant Request for Applications (RFA) is now available! Applications are due by 11:59 pm ET on January 10, 2025. Schools and school districts, CACFP and Summer sponsors, Indian tribal organizations, State agencies, local agencies, non-profit organizations, and agricultural producers are encouraged to apply. Applicants may apply for grants of up to \$100,000 in one of the five grant tracks. State agencies, Indian tribal organizations, or other eligible organizations proposing projects that are multi-state or national in scope may apply for up to \$500,000. RFAs by desired grant tracks:
